

Wish List - October 2011

Sleeper Sofas: Cost \$1,500 per sofa. Each patient room at the Hospice House has a sleeper sofa to allow family and friends to stay the night near their loved one. Several of our current sleeper sofas must be replaced.

Chair replacements for the Hospice House: Cost up to \$2,500 Several of the upholstered chairs at Hospice House, in which family and loved ones sit, are worn out and must be replaced.

Outdoor furniture for the Hospice House: Cost up to \$3,000 These very heavy duty plastic chairs and benches will not tip over and need no maintenance.

Bariatric Lift: Cost \$3,575. This device can lift a patient weighing up to 600 pounds, enabling safe transfers of large patients to and from bed, and reducing potential patient and staff injuries.

Bariatric Bed: Cost \$15,000. This bed is specially designed and built to allow plus size patients to lie comfortably and safely. The bed is longer and wider and has special features just for these patients.

Shared Area Network (SAN) Hard Drive: Cost \$25,000 An SAN hard drive is a device that stores operational software and runs as a major backup system. If any of our servers fail to operate properly, The SAN system will continue to operate as a backup server so staff can continue to access to vital software programs. This type of hard drive will ensure that our computer system stays up and running 7 days a week, 24 hours per day.

Nurse Call System for the Hospice House: Cost \$50,000 We must replace the current nurse call system used by patients and the clinical staff. The current system has outdated components and will no longer be serviced as of December 31, 2011.
